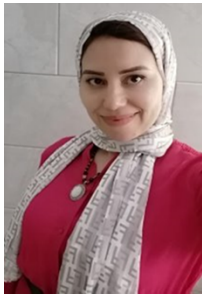


Biodata: Wesam Morsi & Hala Medhat Assem
