Md Al Amin is an Assistant Professor in the Department of English and Humanities at BRAC University. He teaches Applied Linguistics and ELT and supervises thesis students. He has a strong interest in researching English teaching in Bangladesh, English teacher education, English-medium instruction, rural education, and high-stakes examinations. He completed his PhD in 2017 from the University of Canterbury, New Zealand. His doctoral study explored and analysed various forces that shape English language teaching in Bangladesh. He has taught in several countries, including United Kingdom and New Zealand, and at various levels including school and university.

Janinka Greenwood is Emeritus Professor of Education at the University of Canterbury, New Zealand. She is a playwright, poet, author of number of books, editor of several journals, publishes widely and supervises doctoral students. Her research work in the fields of theatre, drama in education, post-colonialisms, critical literacies, education and cross-cultural perspectives have also lead to further examination of particular methodologies such as practitioner research, action research creative work, and to epistemological questions about the cultural locatedness of knowledge.
