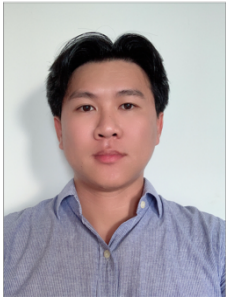


Biodata: Khuong Vo Van, Phuong Le Hoang Ngo, Huy Nguyen Van
